

## **John Bannon proposed trip**

DAY 1 22nd Nov.

Arrival of at Lusaka airport and collect 4X4 and supplies and get en route on Great North Rd.

DAY 2 23rd Nov

Arrive Shiwa N'dango

DAY 3 24th Nov.

Chambeshi memorial – group visit

Overnight Shiwa N'dango – talks on war in Africa

DAY 4 25th Nov.

Mbala – Main memorial service.

Overnight at Chila Lodge

DAY 5 26th Nov.

Suggested , Kalambo Falls and humid Lake Tanganyika---over night at Chila Lodge, or head SE 100 miles to Tunduma/Fife.and over night. This day's itinerary could be missed out---I only mention it in case 4X4 potential party wishes to view. Otherwise, will reduce itinerary by one day.

DAY 6 27th Nov.

Into Tanzania passing by Porota and Tengere mountains/Utinele/Brandt (approx 120 miles) to Tanadala (where 1/4 KAR mustered troops in mid Oct. 1918 up through the Livingstones) and then 30 miles down the Livingstone range to Old Langenburg/Lumbira and over night (if time allows and no customs delays then along north shore of Lake Nyasa to Songwe in Malawi.

DAY 7 28th Nov.

All day back to Fife and via Kayambi Mission and Malima Stream the site (5 miles NE of Kasama) of last battle of WW1, following as much as possible the 1/4 route from 1st Nov. --12th Nov. 1918. Over night Kasama.

DAY 8 29th Nov.

Depart Kasama to Lusaka and over night at reasonably priced hotel near airport and return 4X4.

DAY 9 30th Nov.

Arrange taxi to airport and return to London if Kalambo Falls visit included (my grandfather and Lettow Vorbeck visited the falls around this date) Lake Tanganyika is missed out, then return flight on 29th.Nov. Need to consider if the Tanzania/GEA circuit takes a day longer.
